It's fast and easy to pitch in \$10 bucks a month on the website. Just go to the "**Join Us**" page at www.northwoodsconservancy.org and contribute by credit/debit card (easiest/fastest) or by a checking/savings account (print and mail the auto-debit form to Superior National Bank – we never see this information). Or skip the whole monthly thing and make a single lump-sum donation. If you'd rather just send a check, fold this form into an envelope and mail it in – thanks! All donations are tax deductible and will be used to pay the mortgage on Seven Mile Point. *Donations of \$1,000 or more will be used for principal reduction, as will proceeds from other events in the works (see website for details on the Cobble Gobble 8k, SMP Polar Bear Plunge, SMP Fat Tire 50, and SMP Music on the Beach).*

See SMP for yourself! From Ahmeek (4 miles north of Calumet on US-41) or Eagle River, follow Five Mile Point Road (7.0 miles from Ahmeek, 4.8 miles from Eagle River) and turn west on Sunset Bay Road. After 0.8 miles (at the Sunset Bay Campground entrance), turn left on Seven Mile Point Road and proceed 1.2 miles to SMP. Park at the end-of-the-road turn-around. Sunset Bay Road and SMP Road are private roads; please respect our neighbors.
